TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR OUTSOURCING THE SERVICES OF ENUMERATORS & STATISTICAL COMPUTER OPERATORS

- 1. The Enumerator for EARAS survey should be Madhyamik Passed. The Statistical Computer Operator should be at least HS (+2) Pass and Diploma in Computer Application (DCA) with at least 3 months working experience of handling Crop Cutting Experiment(CCE) data, EARAS data and yield data of PMFBY. The require nos. of Enumerator is 2 (two) nos. and S.C.O is 1 (one) number.
- 2. The initial period of contract would be 12 months subject to the availability of fund, extendable by another 6 months on satisfactory performance with such amendments as may be mutually agreed to and also subject to the necessary approval of the Competent Authority. Remuneration will be paid up to a maximum of Rs. 5000/- per season for Enumerator (total 4 season of EARAS survey per year) and for Statistical Computer Operator upto maximum of Rs.10,000/- per month including Service Charges, tax etc. Rate quoted by the agency would be fixed for a period of Twelve months and any statutory increase in wages etc. is to be absorbed by the agency.
- 3. The manpower will have to be supplied by the agency within 5 days of award of contract.

- 5. An earnest money deposit of Rs. 1,000/- (Rs. OneThousand Only) in the form of Demand Draft Drawn in favour of the **Supdt. of Agriculture**, **Padmabil** is to be submitted along with the technical bid, failing which the bid shall not be considered valid.
- 8. The tenders should be submitted in two sealed covers:
- (A) The first sealed cover should be superscribed as "Technical Bid" and should contain:
 - (i) The proforma at Annexure-I, duly filled in.
 - (ii) Agency profile, including previous experience of manpower supplied to Government Departments.
 - (vi) Acceptance of terms and conditions.
 - (vii) Demand draft for earnest money deposit.
 - (viii) All other required documents.
- (B) The second sealed envelope superscripted "Price Bid" should contain only rates which is to be quoted on monthly basis for normal office duty hours per day per person as per rules of Govt. of Tripura Annex-II (A) & Annex-II (B)
- (C) Both the sealed covers should be placed in the main sealed envelope superscripted "Tender for supply of Outsourced Staff". This should be addressed to the Supdt. of Agriculture, Padmabil Agri. - 7. If the rates/quotations (wages plus the statutory contributions like EPF, ESIC, etc.) submitted by any Agency are found to be less than the minimum wages notified by the Labour Department, Government of Tripura, the bids of such an Agency will not be considered.
- 8. The technical bids will be opened by the authority if possible at **3.30** pm on 2-7-2018 in presence of the participating bidders who may like to be present. In-between if any holiday declares by the Govt. on scheduled date i.e. on 2-7-2018, dropping of tender / tender will be receive on next working day.
- 9. The authority will assess the ability of the agencies to supply requisite number of personnel. The agency selected by the authority will have to send a panel of Enumerators and Data Entry Operators registered with them to this office for a practical test on the basis of which the Data Entry Operators will be engaged.
- 10. All services on outsourcing basis shall be performed by persons qualified and skilled in performing such services as per the eligibility criteria.
- 11. The persons supplied by the Agency should not have any adverse Police records/criminal cases against them. The agency should make adequate enquiries about the character and antecedents of the persons whom they are recommending. The character and antecedents of each personnel of the service provider will be got verified by the service provider before their deployment after investigation by the local Police, collecting proofs of identity like driving license, bank account details, previous work experience, proof of residence and recent photograph and a certification to this effect submitted to this office. The service provider will also ensure that the personnel deployed are medically fit and will keep in record a certificate of their medical fitness. The service provider shall withdraw such employees who are not found suitable by this office for any reasons immediately on receipt of such a request.
- 12. The service provider shall engage necessary number of persons as required by this office from time to time. The said persons engaged by the service provider shall be the employee of the service provider and it shall be the duty of the service provider to pay their salary every month. There is no Master and Servant or Employer and Employees relationship between the employees of the service provider and this office and further the said persons of the service provider shall not claim any employment, engagement or absorption in the Department of Agriculture, Govt. of Tripura in future.
- 13. The service provider's persons shall not claim any benefit/ compensation/absorption/regularization of service from/in this Department under the provision of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 or Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970. Undertakings from the persons to this effect shall be required to be submitted by the service provider to this office.
- 14. The service provider's personnel shall not divulge or disclose to any person any details of office operation process, technical know-how, security arrangements, administrative / organizational matters as all are confidential / secret in nature.
- 15. The service providers personnel's should be polite, cordial, positive and efficient while handling the assigned work and their actions shall promote goodwill and enhance the image of this office. The service provider shall be responsible for any act of indiscipline on the part of persons deployed by him.
- 16. The persons deputed shall not be below the age of 18 years or above 35 years and they shall not interfere with the duties of the employees of the Department.
- 17. The Department may require the service provider to dismiss or remove from the site of work any person or persons employed by the service provider who may be incompetent or for his/her/their

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misconduct and the service provider shall forthwith comply with such requirements. The service provider shall replace immediately any of its personnel if they are unacceptable to this Department because of security risk, incompetence, conflict of interest and breach of confidentiality or improper conduct upon receiving written notice from this Department.

- 18. The service provider has to provide photo identity cards to the persons employed by him/her for carrying out the work. These cards are to be constantly displayed & their loss reported immediately.
- 19. The service provider shall ensure proper conduct of his persons in office premises and enforce prohibition of consumption of alcoholic drinks, paan, smoking, loitering without work.
- 20. The transportation, food, medical and other statutory requirements in respect of each personnel of the service provider shall be responsibility of the service provider and the office shall not be liable or responsible on any of these accounts towards any personnel of the service provider.
- 21. Working hours would be normally from 10.00 A.M. to 5.30 P.M. during working days including ½ an hour lunch break in between. However, in exigencies of work they may be required to sit late and the personnel may be called on Saturday, Sunday and other Gazette holidays, if required.
- 22. That the agency will be wholly and exclusively responsible for payment of wages to the persons engaged by it in compliance of all the statutory obligations under all related legislations as applicable to it from time to time including Minimum Wages Act, Employees Provident Fund, ESI Act, etc. and this Department shall not incur any liability for any expenditure whatsoever on the persons employed by the Agency on account of any obligation. The agency will be required to provide particulars of PF, Group Insurance of its employees engaged in this Department.
- 23. The service provider will submit the bill, in triplicate, in respect of a particular month in the first week of the following month. The payment will be released by the third week of the following month after deduction of taxes deductible at source, if applicable, under the laws in force.
- 24. Payments to the service provider would be strictly on certification by the officer with whom the outsourced personnel is attached that his/her service was satisfactory and as per his/her attendance shown in the bill preferred by the service provider.
- 25. No wage/remuneration will be paid to any staff for the days of absence from duty.
- 26. The service provider will provide the required personnel for a shorter period also in case of any exigencies as per the requirement of this office.
- 27. The service provider shall arrange for a substitute well in advance if there is any probability of the person leaving the job due to his/her own personal reasons. The payment in respect of the overlapping period of the substitute shall be the responsibility of the service provider.
- 28. The service provider shall be contactable at all times and message sent by phone/e-mail/Fax/Special Messenger from this office to the service provider shall be acknowledged immediately on receipt on the same day. The service provider shall strictly observe the instructions issued by this office in fulfillment of the contract from time to time.
- 29. This office shall not be liable for any loss, damage, theft, burglary or robbery of any personal belongings, equipment or vehicles of the personnel of the service provider.

- 30. That the Agency on its part and through its own resources shall ensure that the goods, materials and equipment etc. supplied to the personnel for discharge of duties assigned to them are not damaged in the process of carrying out the services undertaken by it and shall be responsible for act of commission and omission on the part of its staff and its employees, etc. If this office suffers any loss or damage on account of negligence, default or theft on the part of the employees/ agents of the agency, then the agency shall be liable to reimburse to this office for the same. The agency shall keep this Department fully indemnified against any such loss or damage.
- 31. This office will maintain an attendance register in respect of the staff deployed by the agency on the basis of which wages/remuneration will be decided in respect of the staff at the approved rates.
- 32. Remuneration for 1 (One) month shall be kept as a security deposit in the office of the undersigned. The security deposit shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the service provider. The security deposit will be forfeited in case the supply of manpower is delayed beyond the period stipulated by this office or on non-compliance of the terms of agreement by the service provider or frequent absence from duty/misconduct on the part of manpower supplied by the agency.
- 33. The successful bidder will enter into an agreement with this office for supply of suitable and qualified manpower as per requirement of this office on these terms and conditions. The agreement will be valid for a period of 12 months commencing from date of signing such agreement and shall continue to be in force in the same manner unless terminated in writing. The service charges/rates quoted by the agency shall be fixed for a period of 12 months and no request for any change/modification shall be entertained before expiry of the period of 12 months. Any statutory increase in wages/DA, etc. during this period is to be absorbed by the service provider. The contract/agreement is extendable on six months basis subject to satisfactory performance of the agency and such amendments as mutually agreed to subject to the approval of authority.
- 34. The service provider shall not assign, transfer, pledge or sub-contract the performance of service without the prior consent of this office.
- 35. However, the agreement can be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice in advance. If the agency fails to give one month's notice in writing for termination of the agreement then one month's wages, etc. and any amount due to the agency from this office shall be forfeited by the office.
- 36. That on the expiry of the agreement, as mentioned above, the agency will withdraw all its personnel and clear their accounts by paying them all their legal dues.
